

# What we do...

## *Telephone Consultation*

Health care professionals, parents, public health agencies, educators and community members can call our specialists to discuss pediatric environmental health and exposure issues.

## *Referrals and Clinical Consultation*

Pediatric providers can arrange for their patients to be evaluated by a multi-disciplinary team staffed by experts in environmental medicine, pediatrics and clinical toxicology. The clinics are open to children from infancy to adolescence for evaluation of illness that may be related to environmental exposures.

## *Educational Material and Training*

Our specialty-trained staff provides educational programs to health care providers and community groups. Training is provided to resident and practicing physicians in the principles of children's environmental health. Educational materials and resources are accessible via web site or by mail. These materials include information regarding indoor/outdoor air quality, respiratory illness and asthma, neuro-developmental disorders, heavy metal and chemical hazards, and adolescent occupational hazards.

## *Research*

Our clinicians and scientists conduct research in areas such as childhood asthma and air quality, heavy metal and chemical exposures, and neurodevelopmental disorders.
