

# INTERNSHIP PROGRAM TRAINS STUDENTS IN WORKPLACE SAFETY



## THE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH INTERNSHIP PROGRAM (OHIP)

- **Funded by the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH), OHIP is a paid summer internship** helping young people learn about the field of occupational safety and health from workers and their employers.
- **OHIP trains a future specialized workforce of medical and safety professionals who will go on to additional training and may devote careers to making America's workplaces run more efficiently and safely.**

## OHIP PROJECT EXAMPLES

- **Interviewing caregivers** at residential facilities to help improve working conditions
- **Reducing exposures to chemicals** for maintenance workers
- **Ensuring access to the right protective gear** for workers in sawmills and construction jobs
- **Helping standardize engineering controls** by working with employers and contractors
